### **Heritage Landscaping Project**

Council discussed the issues that have been brought to their attention regarding the landscaping project that is ongoing at the Heritage Landing.

### **Site Plan/Land Diagram**

Council reviewed the site plan and the land diagram for the area.

### **Pictures**

- The posts are in the way for the water and sewer.
- There has been work done on Bill Learie's land. The posts must be moved. Mr. Learie to be contacted to see if he wants sod placed in the area and make him aware of what has happened. Mr. Power said that he will re-sod Mr. Learie's land if that is what he wants.
- Heritage New Perlican Committee was told that there would be natural stone used but there is decorative stone.
- Council will request that 1 post be removed (1 that is on Mr. Learie's land closest to the next parcel), the other one moved closer to the landing. On the other side, the 2 posts will be moved, 1 closer to the landing, the other one closer to the next parcel.
- Council will request that the boat display be moved back 4 feet and a cribbing to be built to put 1 boat on top.

### **Email from Heritage New Perlican**

An email from Heritage New Perlican was tabled with their concerns about the project. Council will be meeting with the committee to address these concerns.

### **Letter from I. Piercy**

A letter was tabled from Ivy Piercey, Heritage New Perlican member and a resident of New Perlican showing her support to keep the landing landscaping in the old traditional way.

### **Letter from E. Matthews**

A letter was tabled from Eileen Matthews, member of Heritage New Perlican and a resident of New Perlican, outlining her concerns about the landscaping project. Mrs. Matthews also outlined her many contributions to the Heritage New Perlican Committee and Council would like to acknowledge that they are grateful for her many years of hard work.

### **Letter from T. Peddle**

A letter was received from Terry Peddle, taxpayer of New Perlican, outlining his concerns with the landscaping project. He also referenced previous times that there were items placed on the property that had to be moved due to obstructing parking and usage.

### **Welcome Heritage New Perlican**

Eileen Matthews, Betty Simmons and Ruth Walker from Heritage New Perlican joined the meeting at 2:30pm. Joan Butler and Ivy Piercey sent their regrets.

Council told Heritage New Perlican about the requests that they will put forth to the contractor regarding moving the posts and the boat display. The committee members did not see any issue with the new placement of these items. They did have an issue with the decorative stone being used as it did not fit in with the overall theme of the area. They would like to see natural grey stone instead. The plan was reviewed, and several items were noted as not being needed: rope fence between the back and boat display, due to wriggle fence, barrels with flowers, solar lights. It was discussed that by not needing these items, plus the savings from the work that does not need to be done on the side towards Mr. Learie's land, the money saved can go towards the natural stone for the post.

Council thanked the Heritage New Perlican for their input and for coming to the meeting. The members left at 3:05pm.

Council asked that Mr. Bill Power attend the beginning of the Council meeting that is taking place on Thursday, June 17<sup>th</sup>, 2021 to discuss the project.
