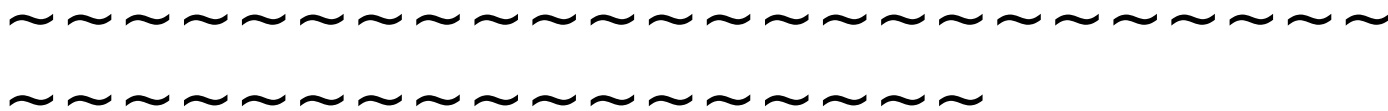


# New Perlican Town Crier
