W. C. Palmer Mural

Heritage New Perlican has received funding to restore and preserve the mural. They want to leave it down on the back wall, covered in lexcon. A copy of the timeline that happened in 2019 with the mural was given to all present to review. Members of the New Perlican Recreation Committee stated that plug ins in a commercial building have to be 6 feet apart and if the mural is left down, it will eliminate a plug, thereby violating fire code regulations. Discussion took place on where it should be placed and how to preserve it. There were questions of people on committees and on Council at the same time and being in a conflict of interest when discussing matters regarding the committee. The Department of Municipal and Provincial Affairs was contacted, and Trina Hackett said that the mural being up or down would not affect the committee financially, so conflict of interest does not come into play. The last that the New Perlican Recreation Committee had heard was that the Heritage New Perlican Committee was seeking funding for a pulley system, but they did not know that this application was not successful. It is unknown if the mural can be rolled when the restoration and preservation take place. Council stated that they need to discuss this further and if the mural cannot be rolled up, then a meeting will take place with Council, Heritage New Perlican and the New Perlican Recreation Committee.

Bar

The bar needs to be lifted and placed back up on the blocks and a light needs to be replaced in the storage room. Work orders will be completed for when the Superintendent of Works returns to work. Discussion also took place regarding heaters in the bar and kitchen. This will be referred to a Council meeting for further discussion as quotes would be needed for the work.

Roof

There are leaks over the bar and roof. There may be problems with the shingles in the valleys on the roof. There have been no leaks over the bar since October when the roof was gummed in that area. Over the kitchen was a result of ice build up under the shingles. There were 6 requests for quotes sent out in 2021 with no response for the roof repairs. There is money available through the Community Healthy Living Fund for repairs to centers, but the applications are not open yet. This will be further discussed at a Council meeting.
