Heritage New Perlican Letter to Council - June 25th, 2022

A letter was reviewed from Heritage New Perlican that was tabled at the regular Council meeting of June 30th, 2022. Heritage New Perlican expressed their concerns that a travel trailer was placed on a property that is on the corner of Harbour Road and Tory Road without the input of the committee as per the Town of New Perlican Heritage Regulations that were adopted September 11th, 2014. Council acknowledged that it was an oversight on their part as many of them were not aware of the regulations and assured the committee that they will be notified in the future. Discussion took place about the travel trailer, and it is permitted on the property as it is owned by the property owner, and it is permissible under the New Perlican Municipal Plan to have 1 travel trailer on your property year-round if it is owned by the property owner. The address for the property is on Tory Road and not Harbour Road. Council was also asked if the travel trailer is connected to water, and sewer services and it is not.

New Perlican Municipal Town Plan

Proposed changes to the Heritage Conservation Zone for the New Perlican Municipal Plan were reviewed. In the old plan, the area went from the Brookside Building to New Road, Tory Road, Harbour Road and all places in between. Under the new plan, it would be Harbour Road down to Bloody Point. Council asked for the changes to open the area for growth. Heritage New Perlican had no issue with the change if Harbour Road was still considered Heritage Conservation.

Boat Display - Heritage Landing

Discussion took place regarding the building of a boat display at the Heritage Landing for the old row boats. It was decided not to place the boats on display at the landing.

Membership/Council Representative

Discussion took place on the problems with getting members to join the committee. The possibility of combining the Tourism Economic Committee with Heritage New Perlican was mentioned but only 3 people have put their name in for that committee. The members present indicated that they are willing to stay on to look after heritage matters but will not be a committee per se as the numbers are below what is needed as outlined in the regulations. There will be no regular meetings scheduled. Council would need to make a motion at a regular Council meeting giving them permission to stay on at a reduced number.

Request

Heritage New Perlican asked that the chairs be moved from the corner by the mural before the unveiling on Saturday and Council said that this will be done. The committee is going to put something in place by the mural so people cannot get too close. Cleaning the lexcan was also discussed and Heritage New Perlican agreed to do the cleaning when needed. Grass cutting at the grave on Pinsent’s Lane was also discussed. It was questioned whether the summer students had done it. Councillor St. George said that Charlie Peddle was asked to do it and it was done.

Invitation

Council was given an invitation to the W. C. Palmer Mural unveiling on Saturday, September 24th, 2022 from 2:00pm – 4:00pm.

Bloody Point Signs

Heritage New Perlican asked that 2 signs be installed for the Bloody Point gravesites by the maintenance staff. The one that goes up in the garden will be placed in the Spring of 2023 but the other will be placed on the post when time permits.
