



BULK GARBAGE/METALS COLLECTION

Residents are advised that Bulk Garbage and Metal Collection will take place from **Monday, June 10th to Thursday, June 13th**. Regular garbage will be collected on Tuesday, June 11th.

Guidelines for Bulk and Metal Collection:

- Collection will start Monday, June 10th at 8:00am and finish on Thursday, June 13 at 1:00pm. If any items are placed out after this time, it will not be collected.
- Place bulk items next to your garbage box or where waste is normally placed for the weekly collection.
- Separate metal items from other bulk waste.
- Do not stack items.
- Waste must be accessible and boxes free of debris.
- All items must be bagged or bundled and tied. Scattered or loose items will not be collected. If your items are just thrown in a pile they will not be picked up.
- Only 1 pick up load maximum per household/property.
- Individual items must not exceed 22kg (50lb).

ACCEPTABLE ITEMS

- Sofas, Tables, Chairs, and furniture
- Children's Toys
- Desks and bookshelves
- Fridges (Doors removed), stoves, washers, dryers, and other household appliances
- Box springs and mattresses
- Dressers and bathroom fixtures
- Carpet and Flooring tied in rolls less than 1.5m (4 ft) and less than 20 kg (45 lbs)
- Doors and window boxes (glass must be removed)
- Tree limbs tied in bundles less than 1.5m (4 ft), less than 20 kg (45 lbs)
- Glass, securely placed in puncture-proof packaging and gas, marked as BROKEN GLASS
- Iron & removable car parts less than 20 kg (45lbs) (all fluids must be removed by resident prior to collection)
- Other bulk items normally associated with a household

NOT ACCEPTABLE

- Scattered or loose items
- Wood over 4 ft long
- Glass that is not packaged
- Items that do not fit in a pickup truck
- Electronics
- Fire pits and loose ash
- Shingles and construction materials
- Vehicle Parts greater than 20kg (45lbs)
- Tires
- Fish nets and ropes
- Car wrecks, car chassis, & frames
- Animal carcasses & special wastes
- Hazardous Waste - ie propane tanks, oil, etc
- Brick & Concrete
- Earthen materials, stumps & large trees
- Recyclables
- Excrement & liquid waste
- Biomedical waste
- Household garbage

Recycling

Starting **Tuesday, June 4th**, recycling will be picked up. This will take place every 2 weeks. Please ensure that you follow the correct policies regarding blue bag recycling. Please ensure that containers are rinsed prior to disposal.

Mixed Blue Bag

- Water and drink bottles
- Aluminum cans
- Soup and canned food tins
- Foil containers
- Aluminum trays
- Plastic food trays
- Condiment bottles
- Household cleaner bottles
- Toiletry containers
- Milk, juice and soup cartons

Paper and Cardboard Blue Bag

- Corrugated boxes
- Packaging paper
- Drink and coffee trays
- Egg cartons
- Food and cereal boxes
- Gift and shoe boxes
- Paper bags
- Newspapers, flyers and magazines
- Office paper and envelopes
- Construction Paper
